Public Comments

- There were no public comments made. John Moore moved to the next item on the agenda.

Review and Approve Meeting Minutes of November 8, 2006

- The committee members present had no proposed changes for the 11/8/06 meeting minutes. Ruben Dominguez made a motion to accept the minutes & David Hernandez seconds the motion. The vote was unanimous to approve the minutes as noted.

Old Business

John asked if there has been any interaction with CBOC members and their adopted schools or communities.

- Bonnie Mace commented on Silver Creek and said that it has progressed very nicely over the last few months. She also mentioned that it is impossible to get into the driveway at Andrew Hill because of the construction that is going on there. Alan Garofalo agreed that it is difficult and added that it will be between 8 – 10 months before the parking lot there is fully constructed.
- Other committee members had no comments at this time.

Overview of Measure G Project

- Ricardo Reyes went through an overview of a list of projects currently going on.
- John Moore added that campus meetings are held & that they are very informative about the work that is going on at the campuses and he encouraged the committee members to attend at least one of them.

New Business

- New committee members introduced themselves and stated which school/community they were representing.
John Moore described that the purpose of this committee is to report to the Board of Trustees, in public forum, that the funds for the Measure G Bond is being spent in accordance to the Bond language.
- David Hernandez brought up the need for a continuation high school. Particularly in the southern part of the school district. He feels this would help the District send the message that all is being done to provide alternative services for the students. Alan Garofalo answered that that need has been acknowledged but that the Ed Code will not allow a continuation school on a comprehensive high school campus. Also, Measure G does not call for the building of a new school or a continuation school that is unnamed. The District is looking to partner with the City and there are other funds available that are being looked into.
